□ 주요 내용

○ 환영사

- EBRD는 키르기스스탄, 카자흐스탄, 몽골, 타지키스탄, 투르크메니스탄, 우즈베키스탄 등의 6개국 중앙아시아에 강한 현지 입지(local presence)를 가지고 있으며, 6개국은 각각 다른 경제발전 단계에 있으나 모두 큰 성장 잠재력을 가지고 있음
- 중앙아시아 시장은 EBRD의 최우선 순위(top priority) 지역 중 하나이며, 주된 사업 분야는 국유기업(SOEs) 사유화, PPP 법 제도 정립 등의 정책 개혁(policy reform)임
- 한국 투자자들은 녹색경제 및 기후회복력 있는 파이낸싱 (green economy and climate resilient financing), 디지털 전환 (digitalization), 거버넌스 개선(improving governance), 중앙아시아 지역 내 연계성 강화(regional connectivity) 등에 전략적 참여 가능
- 또한 EBRD는 첫째, 상업은행보다 한 발짝 앞서나가며 둘째, 고객 맞춤형 파이낸싱을 제공하고 셋째, 로컬 지식과 네트워크 기반으로 사업에 투자하는 것을 목표로 하고 있으며, 우즈베크의 시설원에 에너지 사업 등 신재생 에너지 관련하여 상업은행 및 투자자들과의 협조 융자(co-financing) 사업을 환영 함

○ 인프라 분야 진출 전략 및 사례

- EBRD는 중앙아시아 지역의 가장 큰 투자자이며, 1991년부터 1,470억 유로 규모의 5,984 건 사업에 투자해왔고, 민간 투자 규모(10%)는 작지만 증가 중
- 중앙아시아 지역에서는 도로, 보건, 폐수처리 부문과 전통적 공공조달 또는 PPP 사업의 형태가 예정사업(pipeline)의 큰 부분을 차지하

며, '녹색인프라(green infrastructure)' 테마는 각국 정부로부터 지지를 받고 있음

- 카자흐스탄 투자 기회

- 카자흐스탄 병원 현대화 프로그램 (Hospitals Modernisation Programme (HMP)은 40억불을 투자하여 19개 병원시설의 병상을 현대화하는 것이며, PPP 방식을 통한 재원조달이 핵심 ('21년 3분기 PPP 입찰 예정)
- 카자흐스탄 HMP 파일럿 PPP사업은 알마티(Almaty)시에 300개 병상 규모의 종합 병원을 건설·관리하는 1억~1.4억불 규모의 사업이며, AP(Availability Payment) 방식으로 진행될 예정 (입찰 서류 승인과정에 있으며 '21년 3분기 입찰확정 예정)

- 우즈베키스탄 투자 기회

- 우즈베크 타슈켄트(Tashkent)-사마르칸트(Samarkand) 도로 PPP사업은 '21년 상반기 내 예비타당성 조사 완료 후 구체적인 사업 타임라인 및 구조가 확정될 예정
- 우즈베크 타슈켄트(Tashkent)-안디잔(Andizhan) 도로 사업은 수도 타슈켄트와 인구밀집도가 가장 높은 페르가나 벨리(Fergana Valley)를 잇는 358km 길이의 도로 및 터널 건설 사업이며, 현재 예·타 완료 후 정부에서 PPP 방식 추진 여부 검토 중
- 사마르칸트(Samarkand), 부하라(Bukhara), 카쉬카다르야(Kashkadarya), 나망간(Namangan) 지역에서 진행될 수처리 사업 등이 있으며, 현재까지 한국 기업의 폐수처리 투자 사례가 없으므로 우수한 한국 기업의 EBRD 프로젝트 참여를 기대함
- 이외에도 타슈켄트 지역의 14개 공립 학교 설립, 타슈켄트 공항을 포함한 9개 지방 공항 현대화 및 운영 등이 pipeline 사업에

올라와 있으며, EBRD 홈페이지에서 자금시장 진출 정보를 얻을 수 있음

○ 에너지 분야 진출 전략 및 사례

- 중앙아시아 에너지 부문은 녹색 신재생 에너지를 지향하며, 현재까지 8억불 규모의 신재생 에너지 투자가 EBRD 차원에서 이루어짐
- '14년에서 '21년까지 이루어진 투자는 다음과 같으며 최근 중앙아시아 지역의 지속가능한 발전을 위한 친환경 사업 등 다양한 사업 기회가 존재하는 만큼 우수한 기술을 보유한 한국 기업의 EBRD 사업 참여를 기대함

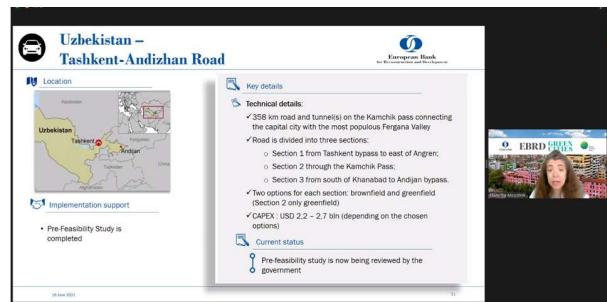
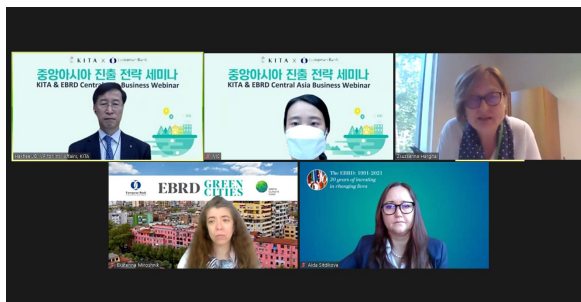


○ 질의 응답 및 토론

- 지방에는 여전히 상하수도 시설이 부족하며, 물 부문에서는 물 누출 탐지, 폐수처리 시설, 관개시설 등의 분야에 대한 니즈가 있음
- EBRD 사업 참여 조건은 투자 제안서에 따라 다르지만 통상적으로 매출규모 최소 1억불 이상의 기업이 참여 중이며, 매출규모, 재무상태 외에도 기존의 경력 또는 기술, 즉 해당 분야에 대한 포트폴리오가 중요함 (중앙아시아 지역 실적이 아니어도 상관없음)

- EBRD가 투자한 가장 큰 규모의 파이낸싱은 현재까지 2억불 규모의 사업이나, 투자 상한선(upper cap)은 투자 구조 (협조융자 비율, 에퀴티 비중) 등에 따라 달라질 가능성이 다분함
- EBRD의 공식적인 한국 연락 채널(contact point)은 없으나 한국무역협회를 통해 2-3페이지 투자 제안서 요약본을 전달하면 적극적으로 상담에 임하겠음
- 전기차 생산에 활용되는 리튬배터리 생산 공장 관련 사업은 EBRD가 매우 환영하는 사업이며 우수한 기술을 보유한 한국 기업의 참여를 기대함

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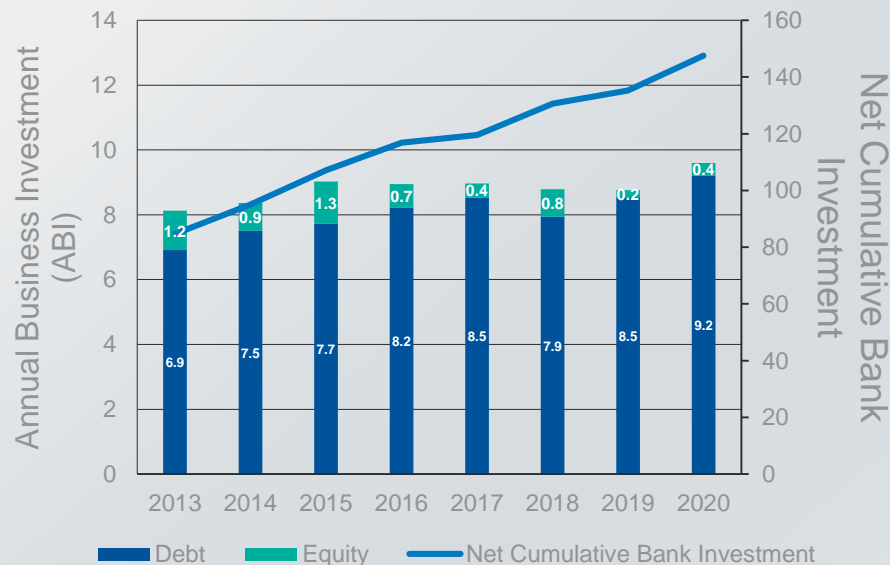

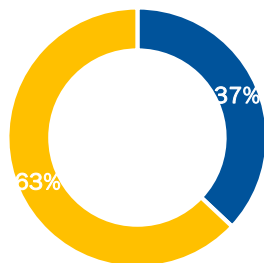

Portfolio by sector

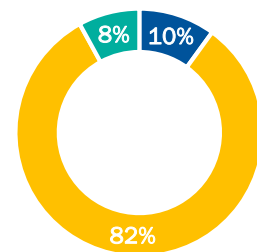
Share of current portfolio

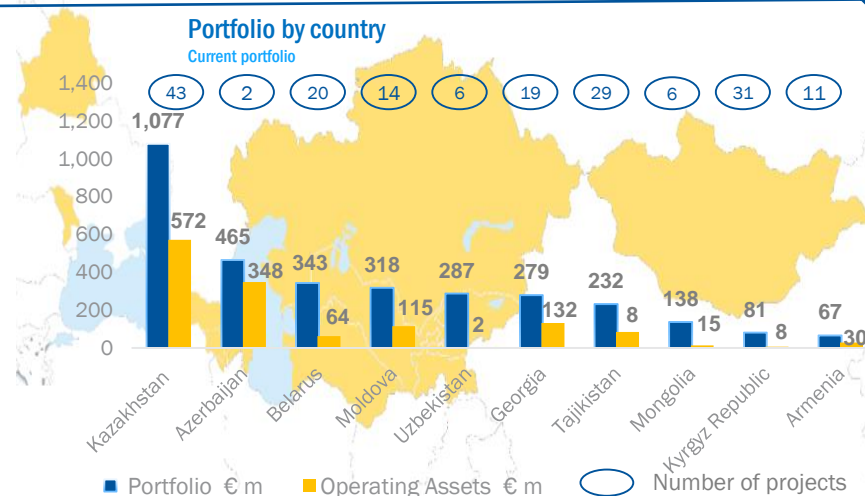
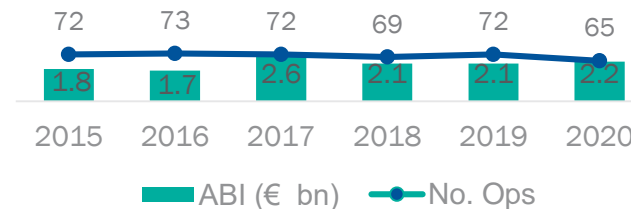
Portfolio by type

Enabling environment e.g. PPP legislation. **BAKAD**, the first PPP in Central Asia reached financial close in August 2020!

+ Ambitious infrastructure development pipeline in the road, healthcare and wastewater treatment sectors (traditional public procurement and PPPs)

Green infrastructure is now a very common theme and supported by many governments in Central Asia

Large-scale projects are only possible with a recourse to sovereign

— Borrowing capacity of the states may be severely affected by the ongoing COVID crisis

Infrastructure user charges in many sectors remain below cost recovery levels and tariff regulation is hard to rely on for long-term investors



Kazakhstan – Hospitals Modernisation Programme (HMP)



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Location



Implementation support

- Health planning
- Technical, legal, financial and environmental feasibility study for hospitals
- Institutional Support to the Ministry of healthcare in PPP capacity building



Key details



Project description: The programme covers development of 19 hospital facilities to modernise 40% of Kazakhstan's bed capacity by 2025



Investments: USD 4 bln programme will be financed using PPP (Facility Management - **FM**) models or USPs or via DBOM contracts on a sovereign basis



Grantor: Ministry of Health



Programme's benefits:

- ✓ Modernisation of existing bed capacity up to the international standards
- ✓ Development of brand-new healthcare facilities appropriately responding to the healthcare needs in the respective regions
- ✓ Implementation of the innovative DBOM contracts and strengthening PPP in facility management



Current status

Flagship is Almaty University (Asfendiyarova) PPP (tender expected in Q3 2021)

Implementation support

- Consultancy support for project preparation is provided by KPPF, local publicly owned PPP advisor and IPPF
- Tender documentation was prepared by KPPF, and was revised by international consultants hired under IPPF management



Key details



Project description: Construction and facility management of multidisciplinary hospital in Almaty city (population around 2 million) for 300 beds (medical services will be provided by National Medical University)



Investments: USD 100-140 million (including contingencies, excluding VAT)



Grantor: Ministry of Health



Project's benefits: First facility management (FM) PPP project in Central Asia



Key terms: Contract type: DBFM; Term: 18 years; Availability payment for facility management; Revenues from non-clinical commercial services



Current status

- Tender documentation is at Government approval stage
- Tender announcement is expected in Q2 2021



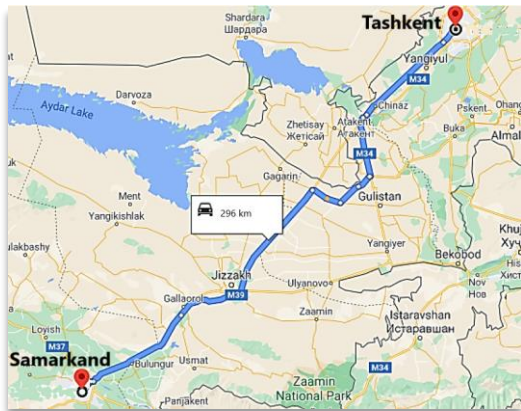
Uzbekistan – Tashkent-Samarkand Road PPP



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Location



Implementation support

- Phase-zero is completed (preliminary assessment of the feasibility, visual inspection of the road)
- Pre-Feasibility Study consultant is hired



Key details



Technical details:

- ✓ Three alignment options are considered: complete new alignment, reconstruction with bypasses and reconstruction of existing road;
- ✓ Preliminary CAPEX estimations: EUR 1,3 – 2,0 bln (to be confirmed by the results of Pre-Feasibility Study);
- ✓ Project phasing (different contracts for the sections) is under consideration and shall be finalized after Pre-Feasibility stage;
- ✓ Road category I-a, Designed Speed – 150 km / h;
- ✓ Total length, km – 277-305;
- ✓ Number of lanes – 4;
- ✓ Length of major bridges and overpasses, km – 5-8;
- ✓ Number of underpasses – 109-112;
- ✓ Number of petrol and service stations, recreation areas, road maintenance divisions – 53-61.



Current status



Pre-FS will be completed in H1 2021. Then the project timeline and project structure will be defined

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Location



Implementation support

- Pre-Feasibility Study is completed



Key details



Technical details:

- ✓ 358 km road and tunnel(s) on the Kamchik pass connecting the capital city with the most populous Fergana Valley
- ✓ Road is divided into three sections:
 - Section 1 from Tashkent bypass to east of Angren;
 - Section 2 through the Kamchik Pass;
 - Section 3 from south of Khanabad to Andijan bypass.
- ✓ Two options for each section: brownfield and greenfield (Section 2 only greenfield)
- ✓ CAPEX : USD 2,2 – 2,7 bln (depending on the chosen options)



Current status



Pre-feasibility study is now being reviewed by the government

Uzbekistan – Social and Environmental Infrastructure



Water Supply and Sewerage PPPs

- in Samarkand, Bukhara, Kashkadarya and Namangan regions
- The projects' preparation is supported by ADB
- Namangan Waste Water Treatment Plant is at the most advanced stage. EoI were received from 23 companies. Pre-qualification results - 5 consortia pre-qualified.



Public schools

- 14 public schools in different districts of Tashkent City and Tashkent Region
- The project preparation is supported by ADB. The project is at an early stage.

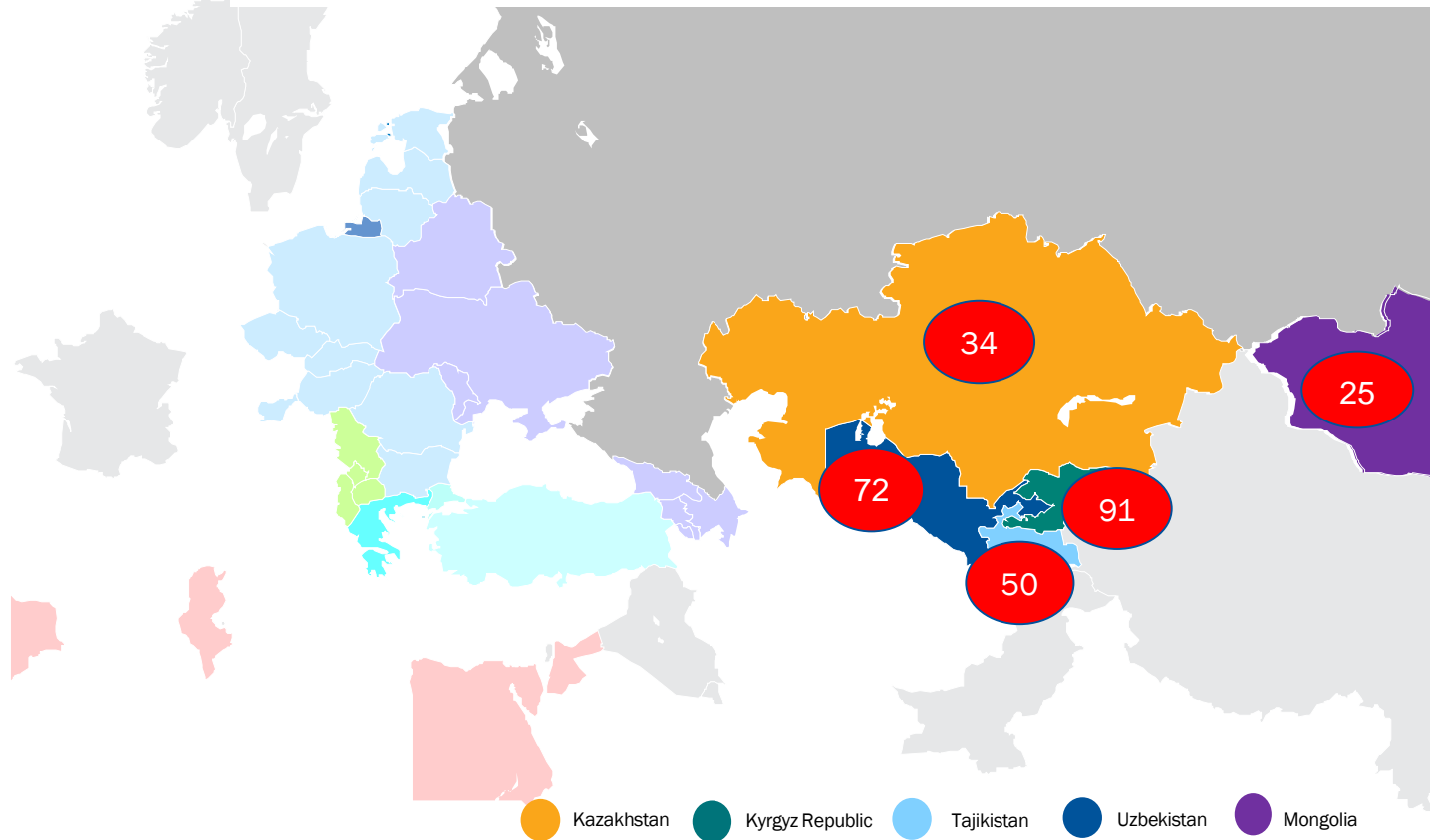


Modernisation and operation of Tashkent Airport as well as nine regional airports in Urgench, Bukhara, Nukus, Fergana, Namangan, Termez, Navoi, Andizhan and Karshi.

- Strategic options analysis (which airports should be bundled, which procurement option will be the most optimal, etc.) is under way.

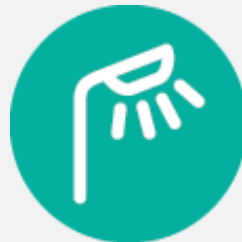

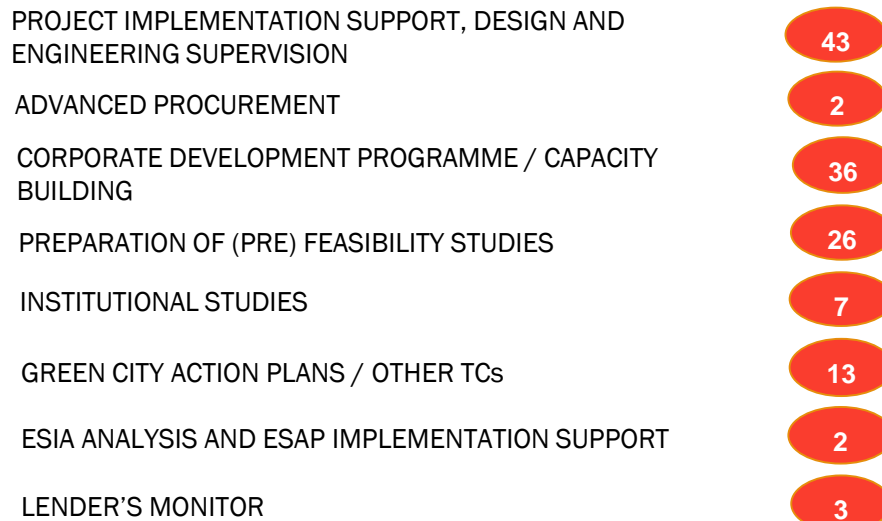
